



Rack Mount Setup Instructions













Using the paper template as a guide, insert the clipnuts where you want to place the Autoloader.

A. Install two clipnuts into each front rail of the rack. To ensure a level shelf, count the holes between each clipnut so that they are in the same position for each rail.


B. Install two clipnuts with one hole open between them on the back rail.

C. Loosely install six 10-32 screws in the four clipnuts on the front rails and the two bottom clipnuts on the back rails.






Insert the filler panel tab into the slot on the bezel opposite the Autoloader side. Snap the filler panel onto the bezel.



If installing two Autoloaders, do not insert the filler panel. After inserting the shelf, remove the cosmetic covers and slide the Autoloaders in side-by-side.




From the back, slide the shelf into the rack until the front lip is over the bezel. Slide the rear lip over the clipnuts on the back rails. Tighten the screws in the bottom clipnuts. Install and tighten two 10-32 screws in the top clipnuts.






5 Remove Feet and Cover




Remove the four screws on the back and two screws on the side of the Autoloader. Remove the cosmetic cover by gently pulling the sides out and then lifting. Unscrew and remove the feet from the Autoloader.

6 Install the Autoloader Unit



From the front, slide the Autoloader onto the shelf until it rests firmly against the support bracket. Install two M4x10 screws through the support bracket into the back of the unit to secure it.


Install the SCSI Bus Adapter

Power on the Autoloader



Connect the power cord into a grounded outlet. Press the standby switch. Power on other peripherals and then the



Loading the Magazine into the Autoloader

With the handle facing out of the Autoloader, insert the magazine into the Autoloader. Slide in until the magazine "clicks" into place. Rotate the handle all the way to the left to store.

Loading Tapes into the Internal Slots

To load internal tapes, remove the magazine from the Autoloader. With the tape's write-protect switch facing out of the Autoloader and the smooth edge facing the top of the slot, insert the tape until it "clicks" into place.



Loading Tapes into the Magazine

With the tape's write-protect switch facing out and the smooth edge facing the top of the magazine, insert the tape until it "clicks." A metal tab will extend to lock it into place.

Rack Mount Kit

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


SCSI Jumper Cable: Connects the drive to the Autoloader on one bus for a standard configuration. See Chapter 1 of the User's Guide for more information.




SCSI Terminator: Terminates the SCSI bus at the end of the chain. See Chapter 1 of the User's Guide for more information.




SCSI Cable: Two meter cable that connects the Autoloader to the host system. See Chapter 1 of the User's Guide for more information.







Tape Cartridges: Includes 5 tape cartridges for data backup and archiving. See Chapter 2 for loading/unloading instructions.


